Presented to selected TASS attendees who are pursuing graduate education at either the Master's, Ph.D., or Ed.D. level, this grant provides selected individuals whose inquiry is related to themes of success for underprepared and underserved students an opportunity to attend the 29th Annual Teaching Academic Survival and Success Conference in Ft. Lauderdale, FL. The scholarship will cover the cost of the registration fee to attend the conference.

Eligibility

The applicant must:

- be currently enrolled in an accredited graduate program related to student success
- not be employed full-time
- demonstrate interest in the success of underprepared or underserved students

Application materials to submit:

- a one to two-page letter addressed to the review committee that describes the applicant's research interest, academic and professional goals. This letter should articulate how TASS conference attendance might further these goals and support the applicant's engagement in student success efforts.
- a brief CV
- one letter of support by a faculty member from the applicant's field
